Note 1: Ball Rep. position

**In 2010, there will be a Ball in Lincoln College. At our last General Meeting, the MCR agreed on a donation of £1500 to the Ball Committee. However, there was some noticeable discontentment about the fact the Ball organisation was mainly in the hands of Undergraduates. The ball president offered to have at least one MCR member in each of the sub-committees, though no Graduate replied to that offer.**

**It is however of high importance that a member of the MCR liaise with the Ball Committee, to ensure that the MCR is kept well informed of the preparations undertaken by the committee and to express the view of the MCR about the Ball in general.**

**The Ball Rep. would have to take part in a weekly meeting with the Ball Executive Committee.**

Note 2: Charity Rep. position

**Traditionally, the MCR transferred charity funds to the JCR, which distributed it independently. Each year, the MCR supports the Vac Proj charity by a donation of £1500.**

**There is also the 1427 Committee, whose role is to strengthen the links between alumni and the college, in which the MCR is currently not represented.**

**Finally, a charity amount is raised from each MCR member battel at the beginning of Michaelmas Term. Again, this amount is distributed to charities by the JCR.**

**The Charity Rep. would have the responsibility to liaise and guarantee the interest of the MCR with the 1427 Committee and with Vac Proj. The Charity Rep. will also collect Charity motions which MCR members will have the opportunity to put forward for MCR General Meetings and manage the MCR Charity Fund.**
